Position Summary:

Residential Counsellors provide general clinical services, such as counselling and treatment initiate and carry out behavioral interventions. The incumbent is responsible, under the supervision of the Residential Supervisor, to provide residential treatment services for males with alcohol and/or other drug problems. A Residential Counsellor primarily supervises and monitors the activities of residential clients in collaboration with a shift partner, facilitates 1 to 2.5 hour structured groups from a prepared lesson plan, and assists with intakes, admissions and discharges. Other duties may, from time to time, be assigned. The incumbent is guided by the policies and procedures of the organization, the Board of Directors, professional standards and ethics and any applicable legislation.
