Position Summary:

The Director of Nursing, reporting to the Senior Director of Clinical Services provides clinical and strategic leadership for nursing across the organization. This includes clinical and administrative oversight of a Rapid Access Addiction Medicine (RAAM) team, other withdrawal management services, select residential programs, Infection Prevention and Control Program, and other internal programs related to Housing and Mental Health.

Minimum Qualifications & Experience:

- Must be a Registered Nurse, RN License required
- Experience in addictions service environments preferred

- Experience providing supervision to Registered Health professionals including Registered Nurses
- At least 7 or more years of experience within the community mental health field

- Experience supporting Infection, Prevention and Control and/or Occupational Health and Safety an asset or be willing to become certified
